2018 ANIMAL NUMBERS

How many animals did HHS take in last year?

HHS took in 621 animals in 2018. This includes 398 cats, 222 dogs, and one ferret.

This is a considerable increase in the number of animals HHS served the year before, when only 222 animals (dogs and cats) were admitted.

So, what happened to all those animals?

141 dogs and 386 cats were adopted in 2018, meaning 527 animals found forever homes because of HHS! Another 93 animals—all but nine of them dogs--were returned to their owners.
